ASSUMED NAME INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. A certificate setting forth the name under which the business is to be transacted and the full names of the persons owning and the addresses of the owners. Certificate is to be notarized and filed in the County Clerk's office. A \$5.00 fee is to be collected at the time of filing.
- 2. Notice of the filing of such certificate shall be published in a local newspaper. Such notice shall be published once a week for 3 consecutive weeks. The first publication shall be within 15 days after the certificate is filed in the County Clerk's office.
- 3. Proof of publication shall be filed with the County Clerk within 50 days from date of filing the certificate.
- 4. Upon proof of publication, the clerk shall issue a receipt to the person filing such certificate, and issue a certificate of ownership of business.
