News Release COVID-19 Case Update

Pike County, IL – October 22, 2020

Pike County Health Department (PCHD) has been notified of 27 additional lab confirmed Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) cases in Pike County.

- 1 female 10-19
- 4 female 20's
- 3 male 20's
- 3 male 30's
- 1 female 40's
- 1 male 40's
- 4 female 50's
- 1 male 50's
- 1 female 60's
- 1 male 60's
- 1 female 70's
- 2 female 80's
- 1 male 80's
- 3 female 90's

A total of 327 lab confirmed and 23 probable COVID-19 cases in Pike County residents have been reported to PCHD. Of those, 163 cases are active, with 12 being hospitalized and 4 deaths reported.

PCHD staff are also working on outbreaks at 3 long term care facilities (Liberty Village, Eastside Health and Rehabilitation Center, Barry Community Care Center), 1 home for the developmentally disabled (Kepley House), 1 school district and 1 large social gathering.

A probable case is defined as a direct household contact of a lab confirmed positive case who is exhibiting the same symptoms.
