Pike County, IL – August 16, 2021

Since our last report on 8/12/21, Pike County Health Department (PCHD) has been notified of 46 new Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) cases in Pike County.

- 4 person(s) 50's
- 10 person(s) 60's
- 1 person(s) 70's

PCHD has also been notified of 3 new COVID-19 related deaths in Pike County.

- 1 person(s) 60's
- 1 person(s) 80's

A total of 2,199 COVID-19, lab confirmed and probable cases in Pike County residents have been reported to PCHD. Of those, 86 cases are active, with 7 being hospitalized and 60 COVID-19 related deaths reported.

A probable case is defined as a direct household contact of a lab confirmed positive case who is exhibiting the same symptoms.
