Pike County, IL – The holiday season is rapidly approaching, so the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has released guidance to help keep family, friends, and your community safe.

Vaccination continues to be the leading public health strategy to end the COVID-19 pandemic. People who are fully vaccinated are at a lower risk of symptomatic or severe infection.

Testing is another way to protect those you love. Testing to see if you are positive for COVID-19 and staying home if you are, is one way to prevent transmission, especially to family and friends who are older and/or have pre-existing conditions that put them at high risk for severe disease.

Holiday Shopping:

- Consider shopping online and having items delivered to your home.
- Avoid crowded shopping times
- Wear a well-fitting mask and maintain physical distance
- Wash your hands with soap and water or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer regularly.
- Do not shop in person if you are sick, have symptoms of COVID-19, or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days, or are awaiting results from a COVID-19 test.
