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PCHD News Release Pike County, IL Still in the Red for Community Transmission of COVID-19

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Pike County, IL – According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Pike County, IL is still in the red, indicating high community transmission of the COVID-19 virus. In the month of October, Pike County Health Department (PCHD) was notified of 82 positive cases of COVID-19. So far, in November, PCHD has already been notified of 26 positive cases, 2 of which (7%) are fully vaccinated. Currently, 43.8% of Pike County residents over the age of 12 are fully vaccinated.

The best way to prevent contracting COVID-19 continues to be socially distancing yourself, washing your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, wearing a tight-fitting mask over the nose and mouth when unable to socially distance and in public, and getting vaccinated.

PCHD will offer COVID-19 vaccinations, including booster shots, on November 18th, and 19th from 1:30 to 4:30 pm at the health department. Please go to www.pikecountyil.org for more information.

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
