News Release COVID-19 Case Update

Pike County, IL – January 18, 2022

Since our last report on 1/4/22, Pike County Health Department (PCHD) has been notified of 633 new Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) cases in Pike County.

- 71 person(s) 0-9
- 128 person(s) 10-19
- 89 person(s) 20's
- 110 person(s) 30's
- 64 person(s) 40's
- 67 person(s) 50's
- 65 person(s) 60's
- 17 person(s) 70's
- 20 person(s) 80's
- 2 person(s) 90's

PCHD has also been notified of 6 new COVID-19 related deaths in Pike County.

- 1 person(s) 50's
- 4 person(s) 80's
- 1 person(s) 90's

A total of 4,296 COVID-19, lab confirmed and probable cases in Pike County residents have been reported to PCHD. Of those, 291 cases are active, with 18 currently hospitalized and 78 COVID-19 related deaths reported.

A probable case is defined as a direct household contact of a lab confirmed positive case who is exhibiting the same symptoms.
