Since our last report on 2/8/22, Pike County Health Department (PCHD) has been notified of 43 new Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) cases in Pike County.

A total of 4,938 COVID-19, lab confirmed and probable cases in Pike County residents have been reported to PCHD. Of those, 35 cases are active, with 5 currently hospitalized and 85 COVID-19 related deaths reported.

A probable case is defined as a direct household contact of a lab confirmed positive case who is exhibiting the same symptoms.
