News Release COVID-19 Case Update

Pike County, IL – April 11, 2022

Since our last report on 4/4/22, Pike County Health Department (PCHD) has been notified of <u>**8**</u> new Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) cases and <u>**1**</u> new COVID-19 related death in Pike County.

A total of 5,019 COVID-19, lab confirmed and probable cases in Pike County residents have been reported to PCHD. Of those, <u>8</u> cases are active, <u>1</u> case remains hospitalized and <u>87</u> COVID-19 related deaths reported.

A probable case is defined as a direct household contact of a lab confirmed positive case who is exhibiting the same symptoms.
