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News Release COVID-19 Case Update

Pike County, IL – May 9, 2022

This will be our last weekly report regarding COVID-19 cases in Pike County. With the availability of COVID-19 home tests, we no longer have an accurate report of cases in our county, as those results are not reported to our agency. Pike County Health Department (PCHD) continues to offer testing twice a week on Monday's and Thursday's (except for holidays) from 8:30 – 11:30 am.

Since our last report on 5/2/22, PCHD has been notified of **6** new Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) cases in Pike County.

A total of $\underline{5,041}$ COVID-19, lab confirmed and probable cases in Pike County residents have been reported to PCHD. Of those, $\underline{4}$ case is active, $\underline{1}$ case remains hospitalized and $\underline{87}$ COVID-19 related deaths reported.

A probable case is defined as a direct household contact of a lab confirmed positive case who is exhibiting the same symptoms.

Please do your part to help slow the spread of COVID-19!
